



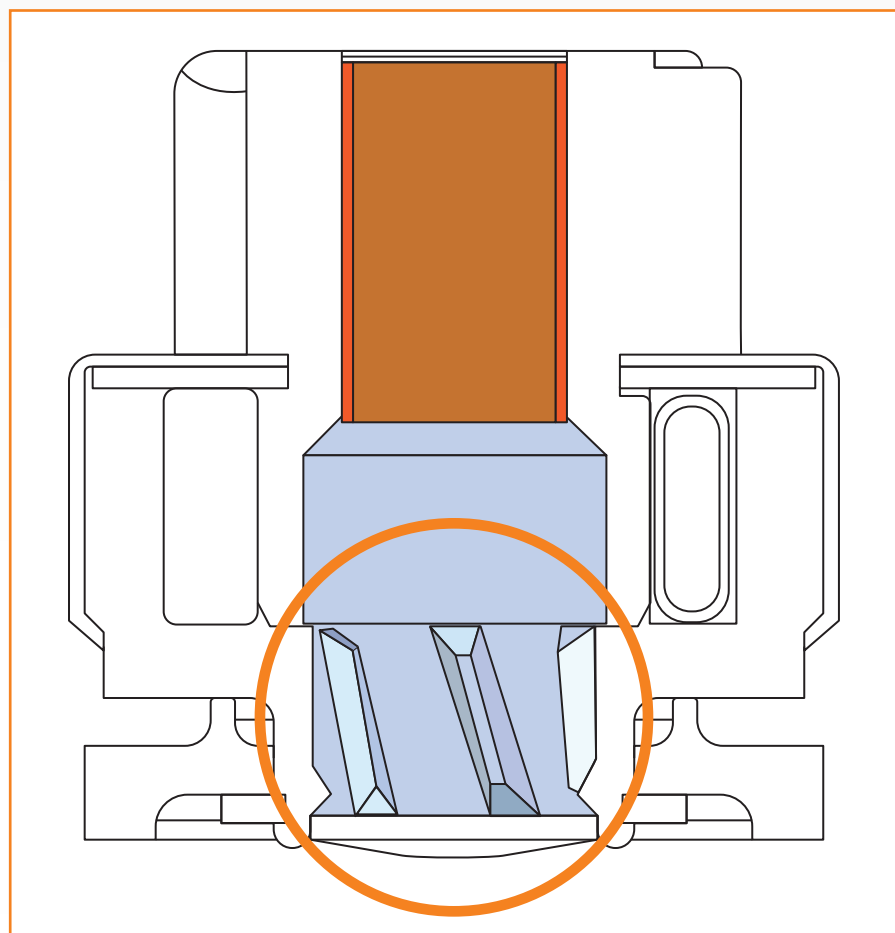
ZEN TECHNICAL TIP #18

DIFFERENCE BETWEEN STARTER DRIVES 1585 AND 1871



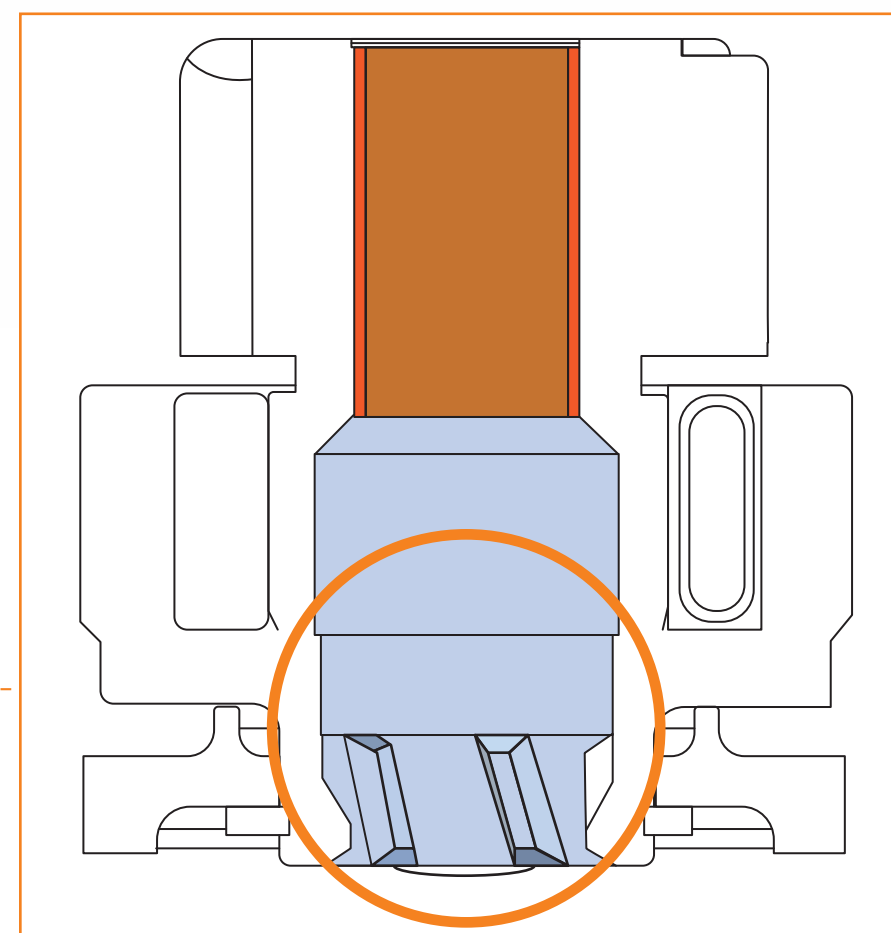
These starter drives have similar features, sizes and applications. But make no mistake, they are not equivalent.

The difference is in the shape of the shaft lock/planetary gear. See more details below:



Drive 1585

The drive is secured to the shaft by **LOCKING THE STOP AT THE END OF THE SHAFT.**



Drive 1871

The drive is secured to the shaft by **LOCKING ONTO THE SPLINES (STOP SPLINE SYSTEM).**
